Aims in RE:

I can retell and suggest meanings to some religious and moral stories, exploring and discussing sacred writings and sources of wisdom and recognising the communities from which they come.

I can recognise some different symbols and actions which express a community's way of life, appreciating some similarities between communities.

I can describe and make connections between different features of the religions and world views I study, discovering more about celebrations, worship, pilgrimages and the rituals which mark important points in life in order to reflect thoughtfully on my ideas.

I can describe and understand links between stories and other aspects of the communities I am investigating, responding thoughtfully to a range of sources of wisdom and to beliefs and teachings that arise from them in different communities.

I can explore and describe a range of beliefs, symbols and actions so that I can understand different ways of life and ways of expressing meaning.
