Ask your child/children about our new habit agreement!

Children are learning that our brain makes new connections every time we learn something new. Imagine a spider's web with lots of interconnected parts that link up. This is a visual way to imagine all the connections we make in our brains. These are called neural pathways. Neurons work in the brain to form neural pathways. The more we practice something new, or make something a habit, the more the brain remembers and develops stronger neural pathways, so, that the habit becomes easier.

Children have agreed to make mindful happy breathing a habit. By practising happy breathing regularly they are teaching themselves to manage their own responses to stress and difficult emotions to help them avoid getting overwhelmed.

Teaching staff wanted to pass on their thanks to the large number of attendees at the recent Parent Consultation Meetings.




