



Updates from Year 4



Next week we will continue with setting descriptions in English, including different grammatical structures (expanded noun phrases etc). We have really enjoyed this so far with great imaginative settings. The children are working on using vocabulary to 'paint an image' in the reader's mind. After learning about the Battle of Hastings, we will look more closely at the Bayeux Tapestry in History. For Art, we will explore the work of William Morris.

In Science, we will explore more about gases and in Music, we will be learning some classic songs such as 'It's a kind of Magic' by Queen! Please ask your child what they have really enjoyed learning in the week.

Homework: Spellings and times tables (TT Rockstars etc). For spellings, the children should ensure that they have looked up the meaning of the words they do not understand. The children have all been given a log in for times table rockstars which was stuck inside their reading record. If they have trouble getting on, please let us know and we can help.
