As another half term comes to an end, and another fantastic module is completed, teachers have completed their end of module surveys and the results are in... and what a huge positive impact My Happy Mind is having on our children!

100% of teachers say this module has helped their class understand their brain and the ways they can look after their own wellbeing

• 100% of teachers are now having 1-3 conversations with children each week about their wellbeing

100% of teachers say their class are now more able to talk about their Character Strengths

"The nursery children have been able to talk about their brain."

"Happy Breathing has helped some of our class with their thoughts and processes and allowed us to calm down when we would usually be upset, frightened or worried."

"The class have been able to identify where they are using their Character Strengths in their day to day lives and can explain which of their strengths they want to work on and why. "

"The children enjoyed thinking of the strengths as super powers."


