What is the research?

Researchers from Oxford Brookes
University are conducting
research exploring the educational
experiences of children from Armed
Forces backgrounds who have
additional learning or support
needs and/or disability.

What would it involve?

Completing an online survey which will take between 10 and 25 minutes to complete. The survey will be open from October to 31 December 2024.

Who can participate?

Parents or carers of a child aged 4-18 with additional needs in UK education or MOD schools overseas, whether diagnosed or not (including children who are currently out of school for any reason).

Year 1/2 Ewes, Chameleons, Rainbow & Bluebirds


As we enter into our final week of this half term we will be embracing the Christmas festivities. There will be lots of crafts, singing and challenges to complete.
